This award may be given to up to two active ETT members who **have** made a significant difference to students and colleagues, in their schools, and communities. This award is to recognize the outstanding contribution in promoting equity in teaching. A cash award of \$300.00 shall be given to each recipient of this award. A teacher may be the recipient of this award once during their career. The recipient(s) of the Excellence in Teaching Equity Award shall be recognized at the Annual Dinner.

Criteria:

The Excellence in Teaching Equity Award may be granted to a current member of ETT who:

- a) is involved in school initiatives
- b) is involved in community initiatives
- c) brings awareness of anti-racism issues
- d) affects lives of students, teachers and community in a positive way
- e) initiates equity focussed club(s), workshop(s) and/or community involvement with an equity focus
- f) is a leader and positive role model for others
- g) has a positive attitude towards diversity which brings about harmony
- h) works collaboratively and inspires others
